

Watercolor Painting Material List

- Nos. 4, 8, 10, 12 round brushes (Silver Black Velvet)
- 140 pound Cold-pressed watercolor paper (half sheet, 22"x15") or 300 pound cold-pressed paper (Preference: Arches or Winsor & Newton)
- A sturdy board, ply wood or bath board, or gator board, size 24"x17" 1/8 inches
- Palette
- Water Bowl
- Frisket (Masking Fluid)- I prefer yellow colored Winsor & Newton
- Cotton rag or paper towels
- Mechanical pencil with .5 mm HB and an eraser
- Spray bottle
- 1.5" tinted masking tape (Scotch 3M)

* Note: Use all the materials you normally use for painting, especially brushes and paints.
