

## Materials:

- Images:
  - Magazines
  - Laser copies of photos (black & white or color). Photos need to have a lot of contrast and must be printed on a **Laser copy machine**. Your local office supply store or FedEx Store is a perfect place to make these copies. (NOTE: Inkjet images will NOT work)
- Mediums:
  - Liquid Matte medium – I like Liquitex Matte Medium
  - Gel medium (gloss or semi-gloss) – I like Golden Soft Gel Semi-gloss
- Paintbrushes and water cup
- Paper towels
- Disposable roasting tray (for wetting papers)
- Substrate / Working Surfaces
  - PROVIDED: Various substrates will be provided (e.g. mixed media paper, wood, canvas board)
  - OPTIONAL:
    - You may wish to bring a piece of artwork that is already started. Image transfers are most interesting when layered with color, lines, and textures that you can add to. Images can be transferred to mixed media paper, canvas, and wood panel.
    - Wood panel or cradle board the size of your choice. Amazon has some good deals on multipacks: [Amazon.com: U.S. Art Supply: Wood Pouring Panels](https://www.amazon.com/s?ref=ast_spl)
- Recommended, but Optional:
  - Acrylic Paint
  - Mark-making tools (e.g. markers, crayons, oil sticks)
  - Miscellaneous collage papers
  - Spray bottle with water in it
