

Fundamental Watercolor Class for Beginners
With Lee Edge

Paints:

- Prang Semi-Moist Watercolor Pans...with 16 colors (Michael's or Jerry's)
- Tube paint: Daniel Smith ONLY Raw Sienna and Ultramarine Blue (can be tiny tube of Holbein or Winsor and Newton)

Brushes:

- Watercolor Brushes...best are sables but \$\$\$, so start with a good quality synthetic like Princeton or similar (Liz at Jerry's Artarama can guide you)
- Brush sizes...2, 4, 6, 10 (If I see a good sale, I will send you a link.)
- Princeton 1 1/2 inch mottler (flat brush)
- (Do not use acrylic brushes for watercolors)

Fabrizio Watercolor (Rag) Paper (may be purchased in class for what I have to pay for it...might be \$9 for a 22" x 30" sheet)

White plastic-coated Masonite Board (I can get these for you for a small fee...maybe \$3 or \$4... let me know if you need one)

4 large Bulldog Clamps or similar (to keep paper on your board)

1 palette or 2-3 white dinner size china plates (thrift shop)

2 water containers (large yogurt containers or larger)

1 roll of Viva smooth paper towels

1 roll of cheaper paper towels for clean up

Graphite Drawing Pencil/ruler-12"/scissors

Grey kneaded eraser

A compass (for drawing circles) IF you have one
