## **Anna Carll: Painting with Paper**

## **Supply list**

- 12 X 18 inch, 20 inch square or 20 x 24 inch heavy paper or panel—this can be wood, Masonite or aluminum panel
- Golden or Liquitex heavy gel—minimum of 8 fluid ounces (if you have some matte medium bring that as well)
- A couple of brushes—1/2" and 1" for larger paper sections
- A large, clean yogurt container or small bucket for your brushes
- A cotton rag or small towel
- A selection of postcards, old calendars, wallpaper samples, maps, periodicals, posters, fine art or handmade papers or any type of paper material you wish to cut-up and use
- A large flat tool to use for burnishing down gelled paper materials
- Sharp scissors (attendees can use an xacto knife for fine detail if they have experience with this tool)
- Pencil or charcoal and eraser
- Cheap sketch paper for building a composition and practice with the gel medium
- An open mind
- NOTE: constructing a collage is a messy business! Wear clothes you don't mind getting gel medium on or bring a painting apron.
