Supply List for Tellico Village Art Guild Fall Path Painting with Carol Robin King

I will provide a 11x14 canvas for our art piece. I will bring extra brushes as well in case you don't have a particular size.

Supplies needed: \*\*\*

Acrylic Paints (Not the thick textured kind but regular tube paints) https://www.jerrysartarama.com/maries-acrylic-colour-set is a great beginner set

Winsor Yellow (or any bright yellow) Ultramarine blue (or your favorite sky blue) Burnt Sienna Black White Bright Orange Sap green or any tree green. (optional colors that we can mix from the above if you don't have them: Raw Sienna, Paynes Gray)

Basic brushes including:

1/2" to 1" flat brush

# 5 or 6 round with nice tip. (I will have plenty to loan out)

Bristle brush ½" or 3/8" round. I will have extras so don't need to buy but these are great to have for bushes and trees! Paper towels

Water container to clean brushes.

Apron or old shirt to protect clothing as Acrylic will stain. (I also will have aprons) Spritz bottle (small from dollar tree is perfect. This is optional for some effects on the trees that I will show)

TIP: Some acrylic sets at places like Walmart are very thinned down and can be difficult to work with as they do not contain much pigment. I recommend brands like Lukas (mid) and Golden (high) but any sets from Jerry's Artarama or Dick Blick, Cheap Joes online or Dick Blick stores are going to be better quality and you can get great deals on a set so you can keep painting at home.

\*\*\* If you do not want to buy a set before trying out acrylics, you can borrow mine for a small fee. I will have brushes as well for anyone to borrow.
