

Memory Pocket Fiber Journal Supply List

Student needs to bring to class:

- Scissors for fabric
- Fabric scraps for pockets & trim (nothing too large)
- Misc trim scraps like rickrack, hem tape, felt, skinny lace, ribbon..etc.
- Misc embellishments like buttons, safety pins, doodads, things to dangle from your journal
- Paper scraps like old notebooks (small), free notepads you get in the mail, old ledger pages...etc...for making journal insert
- Stamps for marking fabric during the painting process. Can be anything that will work with acrylic paint on canvas
- Paint brushes of various sizes - we have some but you may want to control which kinds you use. Nothing fancy required
- Specific acrylic craft paint colors if you have a plan. We will have an array but if you are wanting to stick to certain colors, you may want to bring your own.
- **Sewing machine & thread colors of your choice.** Please fill your bobbins ahead of time if you can. I recommend you stay with black, white and/or neutrals.
- Extra machine needles. I suggest 2 medium woven (14) and maybe 1 heavy woven (18)
- Personal Hair dryer - we will want to have our canvases dry by lunch time so we can assemble. Things will go much quicker if everyone brings their own.

Instructor will provide:

- 24" x 16" canvas fabric
- 4" x 6" photo book insert
- Misc acrylic craft paints, dimensional paint tubes and markers for use
- Some glues and adhesive (although may not be needed)
- Some stamps & objects for stamping
- Some misc ribbon scraps, lace scraps and old zippers
- Clear heavy plastic for see through pockets
- Misc papers for journaling inserts
- Eyelets & tool for attaching so there is a place for dangles
- 2-3 Hair Dryers just as back-up
- 1 sewing machine
