PAPER: At least 5 sheets of 18 x 24-inch newsprint. I'll bring 100 sheets to the class you can use as long as it lasts. If you want to bring your own, Jerry's Artarama sells a 50-sheet pad of Strathmore newsprint for \$10.85. Newsprint is also available at Hobby Lobby.



You'll also need either paper, board, or canvas to begin 2 or 3 paintings. Bring whatever substrait you normally use or something new you want to try.

You should also bring sketch paper or sketch pad.

PIGMENT: We will use watercolor or acrylic since it dries quickly. Use what you have. Mix it up, bring several different pigment types: paint, pencil, pen, stick, marker, or powder.

BRUSHES/IMPLEMENTS: Bring your largest brushes - 3" or 2" (Hake or hardware store brushes are fine), a couple of flat or round brushes size 10 or 12, and yes bring one small brush 4 or 6 flat or round or a rigger. Also bring other tools you use for painting or scraping: palette knives, sticks, rollers, or wedges. Just bring what you have.

MISCELLANEOUS: Bring a pencil, masking tape or white artist tape (½ or 1"), paper towels, water container, and water spray bottle.

NICE TO HAVE: backer board, Q-tips, alcohol, apron, gloves, stencils, stamps, collage papers.
