Supply List for Tellico Village Art Guild Pet Portrait with Carol Robin King

I will provide a 12x12 primed panel for our project and an outline of your pet ready for you to transfer to your panel. This panel will be painted around the edges so you don't have to frame it, but it will fit into a frame easily if you choose to frame it.

I will bring extra brushes and paint as well in case you don't have a particular item.

Supplies needed:

Acrylic Paints (Not the thick textured kind but regular tube paints) https://www.jerrysartarama.com/maries-acrylic-colour-set is a great beginner set

Lots of White at least a 2oz tube full.

Black

Paynes Gray

Blue (preferably ultramarine, Cobalt, Windsor Blue or anything that looks like CocaCola blue)

Rec

Burnt Sienna

Raw Sienna if you have a light tan dog. (I will have extra as this is not a standard in kits.)

If you want an outdoor background like in the sample, please bring green and yellow.

OPTIONAL: If you do not have time to buy paints before class, I will loan my paint. Fee is \$5 and you can pay cash at class for using my paints.

Basic brushes including: I do have extra brushes you can borrow-- but I do not have filberts

3/4" brush flat can have square or round edges as long as its flat (I have extras)

1/4" filbert is very helpful

5 or 6 round with nice tip

Bristle brush ½" or 3/8" Flat or Round will do. I will have extras so don't need to buy but these are great for doing the hair.

Fine Liner brush These are called Liners, rigger or script brushes for fine details.

Paper towels

Water container to clean brushes.

Apron or old shirt to protect clothing as Acrylic will stain.

TIP: Some acrylic sets at places like Walmart are very thinned down and can be difficult to work with as they do not contain much pigment. I recommend brands like Lukas (mid) and Golden (high) but any sets from Jerry's Artarama or Dick Blick, Cheap Joes online are going to be better quality and you can get great deals on a set so you can keep painting at home.
