Thank you for signing up for my Altered Tin class! Listed below are the items I am providing and what you need to bring to class. I also want to give you some “**ideas**” of what to bring.

I am providing:

- 1 - Empty tin (Altoids or similar size)
- small eyelets & jump rings to be used for attachments
- Glues and Paints
- Scissors - large
- Brushes
- Selection of matchboxes for frames in the tins.
- Misc chains for hangers
- Hair dryers for quick drying

You need to bring:

- Doodads for your tin
- Any specialty papers, old photos or misc ephemera you may want to use.
- Precision scissors to fussy cut paper if you have them
- Needle nose pliers if you have them
- Reading glasses if need be - we are working small
- Your Ideas!

Think of a "theme" for your tin..notice mine with the moths (see at end of list) ...could be birds...could be bugs..old photos of a loved one, etc. If you are wondering what the heck "doodads" are....they can be anything small. The list is huge, but think broken jewelry pieces, game pieces, machine parts, old coins, etc. Here is a photo of just a few of the "doodads" I have collected over the years. I have placed a dime in the middle to give you a size reference.



If you are also wondering about “specialty papers” and what that might be. Here is a photo of some of mine from my small paper box. Think old ticket stubs, book pages, candy wrappers, old stamps, plain cards, etc.
